We can't deny that every country has its own history, and the fighter, Martin Luther King Jr., brought a memorable history. He fought for justice for African Americans in the U.S. during the 1950s and 1960s. He worked hard to devote himself to the civil rights movements in this country. He always thought all Americans should be treated equally. Nowadays, most people believe that it doesn't matter which race we belong to, we should be treated without discrimination in the United States. The establishment of civil rights for African Americans was greatly produced by many humane activists for a few decades.

Martin Luther King Jr. was raised by his father who was a Baptist preacher involved with the civil rights movement. After he entered the ministry, King heard a lecture on the nonviolent civil disobedience campaign by Mahatma Gandhi. King convinced that the same methods could be employed by blacks to gain civil rights in the U.S. Afterwards, he became the pastor of the Baptist church in Montgomery, and contributed himself for civil rights movements for a long time. He was awarded for the Nobel Peace Prize for his contribution for the civil rights movement in 1964, but unfortunately he was assassinated in 1968. As a result of all efforts by King and many other activists, the great change happened to African Americans in society of the U.S. Next, one of the things that Mar-

tin Luther King Jr. fought against was the unfair treatment imposed on Rosa Parks which led to the Montgomery Bus Boycott. Rosa Parks was one of the civil rights activists, and also she was the best supporter for Martin. At that time, only white people could sit in front seats on the bus, but she was black, and she was not allowed to be seated. After that, she was arrested and fined by the police. Since Rosa was arrested, Martin with other activists launched a bus boycott, and they strongly protested the bus system until passengers were completely integrated. Martin was arrested and his house was fired through the boycott. After that, more than 17,000 black people walked to work without using busses for thirteen months. Finally, the Montgomery company accepted integration and desegregated for the blacks by the Supreme Court judgment in 1956.

Both Martin Luther King Jr. and Rosa Parks were activists for the African Americans Civil Rights movement between 1955 and 1968. This movement in the U.S. aimed at extermination of racial discrimination against African Americans. In those days, the strict discrimination called "Jim Crow laws" has continued since 1876. The law issued racial segregation in public facilities with a status "Separate but equal" for African Americans. The segregation was enforced at restrooms, restaurants, and drinking fountains for dividing whites and Blacks. With reference to this separation, other racial restrictions concerning accommodations became common in this term. As for one instance,

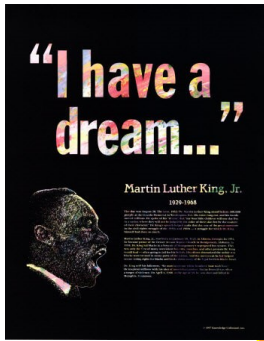
laws in many cities including Los Angeles prohibited the sale or the rental of properties by Asian Americans and Jews as well as Blacks. The activists of the African American Civil Rights movement including Martin Luther King Jr. devoted themselves to restore human rights should be given fairly.

On August 23, 1963, there was the biggest peaceful march on



Washington for Jobs and Freedom. Then more than 250,000 people came together to this huge march, and the King's impressive, "I have a dream" speech is still well known internationally. Finally, his action led to establishment of civil rights as the liberal political agenda in the U.S., and all his efforts considerably changed the Civil Rights Act in 1964.

There were many other activists for civil rights movement besides the two activists previously mentioned, and now we realize that we can share our lives together as the result of every effort by a large number of brave activists. Since civil rights has been legally accepted, people gradually changed social attitudes for African Americans in various fields like sports, arts, entertainments, and politics. we think of deeply understanding to others, and your



own dreams as Martin Luther King Jr. had his dream?

Restaurant Review: Hong Kong Cafe

When we decided to move to Monterey Park, we started searching for delicious food around there. We surfed the Internet, and found some restaurants with good reviews. Now, I would like to recommend you a good restaurant from my list: the Hong Kong Cafe. Their food is tasty with good variety and reasonable prices.

Hong Kong is a famous global center of trade; it is also called Food Paradise because of a great diversity of food. Chinese food, Vietnamese food, Thai food, Indian food, and European food are all popular in Hong Kong. Typical Hong Kong style food includes Rice Plate, Lo Mein, Sandwiches, Snacks and Beverages. At the Hong Kong Cafe, they offer most of those typical foods, in addition; you also can find other styles food, such as Curry, Ramen and Noodle Soup.



As you enter the restaurant, at first, you will feel the atmosphere of Hong Kong. Most of their guests speak Cantonese and Mandarin. The menu is also written in Chinese and English. Also, their walls have posters of Chinese music concerts and shows. The television broadcasts Hong Kong's programs.

This restaurant does not have enough space for big groups, therefore; 2 to 6 people are suggested. Some main dishes might be too much for one person, so you can share your dishes with friends. It is a very popular restaurant, so you might have to wait for available seats during peak hours, and there is no reservation offered.

The Beef with Egg Fried Rice, served with fried beef and scrambled eggs on fried rice is our favorite main dish. The fried beef and scrambled eggs are very tender, and it smells so good. If you do not want to eat beef, you can change to shrimp or barbecue pork instead. Also, you can replace fried rice with steamed rice. Here is a good deal to get cheaper drinks, just add \$1.00 with main dish ordered before 6 p.m. (except Special Drinks) and some of the drinks can be refilled.

The HK Style Bun with Butter, hot bun with cold and thin slice of butter inside, tasting it before the butter melt, you will feel the interesting contrast between the hot bun and the cold butter. The HK Style Steamed Rice Noodle, steamed rice noodle served with peanut butter, soy sauce and spicy sauce is their popular snack. The mixture of these sweet, salty and spicy sauces provides the steamed rice noodle a particular flavor.

If you are interested in Hong Kong style food, or fed up with your daily diet, why not go out for Hong Kong style food for a change? This restaurant will fit your expectations.

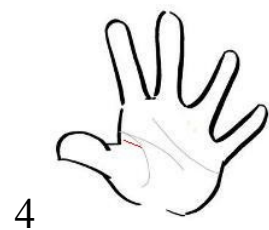
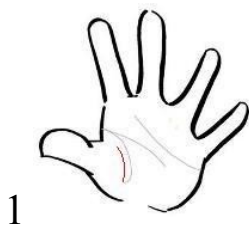

PERFECT HAIRSTYLE FOR

A PERFECT YOU!

Have you ever gone to a salon for a haircut but were confused about what hairstyle you should get? And when you chose what you thought was the perfect hairstyle, and cut your hair, you didn't look as good as you expected? Well, we have some tips of choosing the right haircut based on your facial shape. But first things first: you need to know what facial shape you are.

An Easy Guide Two Step Guide For Finding Your Facial Shape

Step One In the mirror

- Pull your hair back off the face into a pony or for shorter hair use a head band
- Covering one eye, this will help you focus and have a more steady hand
- Using a fine eye, brow, or lip liner, draw the out line of your face onto the mirror.



And If You Like To Be Precise:

Using a tape measure or a ruler take the following measurements, writing them down as you go

Measure your face across the top portion of your cheekbones

Now measure across your jaw line, from the widest point

Next measure across your forehead at it's widest point. (about halfway between eyebrows and hairline)

Last, measure from the tip of your hairline to the chin.

Now, you can now easily find the perfect hairstyles that will compliment you the most!

Oblong Face/Rectangular Face

Characteristics:

Your face is longer than wide and close to the same width across the forehead, jaw line, and cheekbone.

Hair style for Women:



Hairstyle with bangs will shorten an oval face and add width to cheekbones.

Try bangs, as in fringe and just touching the eyebrows. Your ideal hair length is usually neckline with both volume and width present. A fuller cut framing that the nape of the neck will give the visual of a fuller face. (ex. Ashlee Simpsons, Iman, and Angelina Jolie)

Hairstyle for Men:

Your oblong face needs to be shortened, the angularity hidden and the hairline blurred. In a man with a rectangular or oblong shape, the actual hairline should never be strongly angular or obviously exposed. A layered cut is often the best solution allowing hair to form an irregular look at the hairline. For example fauxhawk haircut. (ex. Ben Afflect and Eminem)

Hairstyle to Avoid

Any style that adds height to the top of your head;

Styles on the long side without fullness, this will just drag down your face.

Hair length that travels well past the shoulders, this is going to take a lot of primping, teasing, setting , and styling to add the desired fullness

Heart Shaped Face

Characteristics

Similar to the oval, but the face narrows below the cheekbones, reaching a defined pointy chin.

Hairstyle for Women

Styles that are fuller around the ends will widen the appearance of the chin and jawbone, thus making the face appear better proportioned and basically oval. (ex. Lisa Kudrow, Jennifer Love Hewitt, and Avril Lavigne). Also, a long bob with fringe on a heart-shaped face is great, just make sure the bob falls at your chin or just below it. Long, side swept bangs look great with any length of cut. You can do a shoulder-length cut with long layers, or long hair with these bangs.

Hairstyle for Men



The heart shape works well with deep, full bangs. Not only does this give a broader appearance to the top of the head it softens the pointed forehead. A one-length cut in the back will also add width to the face. Facial hair can help as well. A full beard that is trimmed into a rounded or square shape will disguise the prominent chin. (ex. Kid Rock, Justin Timberlake)

Hairstyle to Avoid

Avoid styles that cling closely to your face, mirroring the heart shape, as well as blunt-cut bangs and harsh, choppy layers. Styles that are shorter than your jaw line. Severe looks that are swept back do not enhance a heart face shape.

Oval Face Shape

Characteristics:

Your face is slightly narrow at the jaw line and you have a rounded hairline (forehead is wider than the chin). You also have prominent cheek bones because the center of your face is the widest point.

Hairstyle for Women:

This is the ideal for any hairstyle. Wispy bangs and one length hair looks best for you if you want to emphasize your eyes, try blunt bangs that hit right at your eyebrows. The best style for oval face is layers at the height of your best features such as cheekbones, lips or chin. (ex. Grace Kelly, Elizabeth Taylor, and Ashley Judd)



Hairstyle for Men:

Attention should be paid to their prominent features such as the nose and position of the eyes and ears. (ex: Barry Watson, Jude Law)

Style to Avoid:

Avoid high volume hair because it can make your face appear long.

Round Face

Characteristics:

If you have a round face, it is important to know and understand the basic geometry of your shape. First, your face is wider in the cheek area than any other area. You will probably also notice that you have a well-rounded chin.

The cheek area will be rounded and very full. However, basically, from the forehead down, the face is relatively short. You will want to add overall length to the face when applying makeup, and try to draw attention away from the well-rounded and full cheek and chin area.



Hairstyle for Women:

Try styles that add fullness and height at the crown. This will create a slimming look. If you have a long hair, try layers and an off center part. Keep the layers relatively close to your face to produce a longer and narrower face. For shorter hair, try to keep hair longer than chin length. (ex. Vanessa Williams, Uma Thurman and Cameron Diaz)

Hairstyle for Men:

Stay away from full or round hairstyles that will make the face more round. Keep the side leaner and style the hair a bit higher at the top and front to provide balance. An off-center part or some waves at eye level will minimize the roundness. (ex. Elijah Wood, Jack Black).

Hairstyle to Avoid:

Avoid chin length curly hair, or chin length bob. Parting your hair at the center or having short chopped bangs will enhance the roundness of your face and add weight to your face shape. Avoid adding volume at the sides of your ears.
